However, the lack of common definition of carbon neutrality or recognized methods results in a growing cynicism about carbon neutrality. The newly released Public Available Specification (PAS 2060) by BSI specifies the requirements to be met by any entity seeking to demonstrate carbon neutrality through the carbon measurement, reduction and offsetting.

- Definition of carbon neutrality
- Steps and pathways to demonstrate carbon neutrality
- Methodologies and standards
- Carbon trading and offsetting
