Programme Highlights:

<u>Castle Peak Power Station</u> (CPPS) is located in the New Territories of Hong Kong and is one of the largest coal fired power stations in the world. It is owned by the Castle Peak Power Company Limited (CAPCO), a joint venture between CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (40%) and ExxonMobil Energy Limited (60%), and is operated by CLP. Two of the units can burn gas as a back up fuel.



CPPS was constructed in the 1980s as the means to meet high growth in Hong Kong's electricity demand and to change CLP's primary fuel from oil to coal. With the Emissions Control Project for reducing sulphur dioxide and nitrogen oxide emissions phasing in from 2010, together with the ongoing emissions management measures in place, these bring the CPPS to be one of the cleanest coal-fired power stations in the world.



'ElectriCity' is CLP's flagship educational facility in Hong Kong. The centre features interesting and informative displays that explain the fundamental principles of electricity, power generation, transmission and distribution. In addition, visitors get to learn more about the fuel sources currently used in Hong Kong.
