Seminar on **Building Operation and Maintenance Manpower in Hong Kong**

Programme Highlights

In 2014, the Building Services Operation and Maintenance Executives Society (BSOMES) took an initiative to provide financial support for a research project, which is the first of its kind aiming to reveal the state of building operation and maintenance (O&M) manpower in Hong Kong. In collaboration with the Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) and with the support of 20 building-related organizations, the project, entitled "A Study on the Building Operation and Maintenance Manpower in Hong Kong", has been completed recently. Altogether 75 organizations and over 400 individuals, who are building O&M stakeholders, participated in two surveys under the project. Presented in this seminar are the key findings of the project, such as number of persons engaged for building O&M works, number of job vacancies, expected changes in manpower, levels of manpower demand and supply, levels of importance and knowledge/ skills of various trades of O&M works, and suggestions for improving the existing O&M manpower. Subsequent to the presentation will be a session for exchange of opinions as well as questions and answers.

He has also chaired a number of programme validation exercises and served as external examiner and accreditation panel member for various academic programmes.
