Joint Technical Visit to EMSD Regional Digital Control Centre (RDCC) and E&M InnoZone

Programme Highlight:

In response to the Hong Kong Smart City Blueprint and EMSD's 2nd 5-year Strategic Plan, EMSD has implemented a series of initiatives to drive Innovation and Technology (I&T) development, including establishing the very first RDCC (Regional Digital Control Centre) for E&M digitalisation and setting up an E&M InnoZone at the EMSD HQs.



The RDCC is responsible for remote real-time equipment monitoring, indicative alarm for fault responses and energy management, etc. with the ultimate goal to enhance E&M assets' operational efficiency and environmental performance by artificial intelligence (AI) and big data analytics.

On the other hand, the E&M InnoZone showcases many interactive I&T projects covering the application of Internet of Things (IoT), automation, artificial intelligence and energy efficiency technologies. The zone aims to pool together local I&T efforts, accelerate the implementation and testing of innovative E&M solutions from universities and start-ups.
